

THE YESTERDAY'S FARMING 2019

EXHIBITORS – CONDITIONS FOR ENTRY

This document contains the terms and conditions of a contract.

Any vehicle arriving at the show without a pass will be directed into the public car park and the standard entrance fee will apply. Entries will close on July 8th

It is essential to enter by this date in order to be included in the programme. Late entries will not be accepted. As this is a 2-day show the Organisers will only accept entries for this period. Passes will not be sent until a signed entry form has been received.

1. DEFINITIONS

1. In these conditions: "Application form" means the Exhibitor's application form on which these Conditions are annexed.

"Conditions" mean the standard terms and conditions set out in this document and (unless the context otherwise requires) included any special terms and conditions agreed in writing between the Organiser and Exhibitor. Exhibits means the exhibit described in the application form annexed hereto.

"Exhibitors" means the person or persons so described in the application form annexed hereto. "Event", means Yesterday's Farming 2019 held at Leaze farm Haselbury Plucknett, as on Saturday 17th & Sunday 18th August 2019 "official" means any person or persons authorised by the Organisers to supervise and oversee the running of this event. "Exhibitors Camping Area" means the camping area set aside for the exhibitors use only. "Exhibitors Car Park" means the car park set aside for Exhibitors use only. "Organiser" mean Yesterdays Farming Ltd.

"Site" means all the land upon which the event is held.

2. ENTRY

2.1 Subject to clause 2.3 below the Organiser permits the Exhibitor to enter the Exhibit and the Exhibitor agrees to show the Exhibit for the full 2 days of the event subject in both cases of these conditions.

2.2 No variation of these shall be binding unless agreed in writing between authorised representatives of the Organiser and the Exhibitor.

2.3 The Organiser reserves the right to refuse entry to any Exhibitor at their discretion without giving reasons.

3. REQUIREMENTS

3.1 No Exhibitor may enter the site after 10am or leave the site before 5pm without permission of the Organiser on any day of the event including SUNDAY.

3.2 Exhibits must be on the show site from 10am to 5pm daily.

4 PASSES Entry passes. i.e. wrist bands.

Each exhibitor will be issued with two wrist bands for your first exhibit. Any additional exhibits will get one wrist band for driver only please state. Children under 16 will not need wrist bands.

4.2 In exceptional circumstances (where additional help is required to operate a machine or exhibit) and in the discretion of the Organiser, a second vehicle pass may be issued which will admit the driver only. Should other persons require entry in the second vehicle, application must be made to the Organiser who will issue the relevant hand passes if deemed appropriate.

4.3 Any additional persons not sanctioned for entry by the Organiser will be charged the standard rate entrance fee.

4.4 If there is a dispute regarding additional passengers the money requested on admission to the Site must be paid. Any query should then be referred to the Organiser, care of the Yesterday's Farming Ltd and the money will be refunded if deemed appropriate by the Organiser.

5. CAMPING

5.1 An Exhibitor with a valid pass may camp in the Exhibitors Camping Area only, on the Site, from Friday 16th AUGUST 2019 until noon on Monday 19th AUGUST 2019.

Other personnel may camp in the Public Campsite.

6. LIABILITY

6.1 The Organiser will not be liable to the Exhibitor, if the event is cancelled, curtailed or altered in any way due to any occurrence outside the Organisers control.

6.2 The Organiser accepts no liability to the Exhibitor for breach of contract, loss, injury or physical damage of any kind howsoever arising whether by statute or otherwise except where death or injury is caused by the negligence of the Organiser, its agent or servants.

6.3 The Exhibitor shall comply with all legislation and regulations regarding Consumer Protection And Health & Safety Measures insofar as these are applicable to Exhibits, which are on display at the Event.

6.4 The Exhibitor shall indemnify and hold the Organiser harmless with respect to all claims of, and liability to, third parties for injury, death, loss or damage of any type arising from the Exhibitors involvement in the Event (and the involvement of anyone for whom he is responsible) except where the same has arisen directly as a result of any negligent act or omission of the Exhibitor.

6.5 The Exhibitor shall be solely responsible for the Exhibit at all times whether at the site or travelling to or from the Event.

7. INSURANCE

7.1 The Exhibitor under takes that the Exhibitor and the Exhibit will be covered by public liability insurance for not less than £5,000,000 while the Exhibit is on the site.

Please put your policy number and the Company you are with where you sign.

7.2 If the Exhibit is Steam Powered the Exhibitor further under takes that it will have the benefit of a valid current Boiler Certificate.

7.3 The Exhibitor agrees to produce the policy or certificate evidencing public liability insurance for inspection at any time on request of the Organiser and in the case of **steam powered exhibits**, to bring any/or relevant boiler certificate/s to the show with the said Exhibit.

Please note that any self propelled vehicle on the road or rally field where the public are present requires RTA insurance and that public liability insurance only covers you if someone is hurt by a static Exhibit.

7.4 The Exhibitor under takes to draw up a risk assessment for the Exhibit give a copy of this to everyone helping with the Exhibit, and guarantees that he/she and any and all other helpers/staff are competent to operate the Exhibit and associated equipment and any Gas/electrical appliances or equipment.

7.5 Where such appliances/equipment are being operated or used for the benefit of the public or are in the public domain then Electrical Plant and equipment must be tested in accordance with IEE regulations.

LPG installations and appliances must be tested to current standard and hold a current certificate.

8. COMPLIANCE

8.1 The Exhibitor agrees to comply with any other **safety requirements and inspections** as deemed appropriate by the Organiser at any time and from time to time.

8.2 The Exhibitor agrees at all times while on site to comply with the conditions and the reasonable requirements of any Official.

9. LAW – This contract shall be governed by the laws of England
